

Wrocław, 07.06.2021 r.

Regulations of the handball tournament "Wrocław Handball Cup" with information on the rules for the safe course of the event during the COVID-19 epidemic for August 24-28, 2021.

## **§1 General provisions**

1. These regulations have been developed in order to define the rules of safety and the rules of operation of all sports facilities and reserved accommodation places (for the attention of clubs).
2. The regulations apply to all participants of the event as well as to outsiders located in the areas listed in §1 point 1 on the days of the event and the normal operation of all facilities from §1 point 1 before and after the event, i.e. in the period from August 24, 2021 to August 28, 2021.

## **§2 Scope of the regulations**

These regulations cover:

1. It introduces the rules of hygiene and sanitary safety for the participants of the tournament and the rules of safe use of sports facilities.
2. It introduces safety rules resulting from the sanitary regime.
3. It introduces orders, prohibitions and restrictions that every participant in the "Wrocław Handball Cup" football tournament must obey (otherwise, they are not allowed to participate in this event in any form).
4. Bystanders entering the facility also accept the regulations of the event without signing any consent.

## **§3 Ensuring hygienic and sanitary safety for guests participating in the event**

1. Before entering the facility listed in §1 point 1 participant of the event is obliged to:
  - 1) To maintain a safe distance from the queue to the entrance to the building and from other people present at the facility, 2 m (except in special situations with the consent of the organizer, the work of the organizers of the tournament, the work of the referee, the positioning of players before and after the competition and their play during the matches during the competition)
  - 2) For disinfecting hands or gloves placed on the hands with the disinfectant at each entrance to each of the facilities listed in §1 point 1;
  - 3) Use of protective masks in accordance with the guidelines that are used in the current regulations and other provisions of national law.

**2.** Guests and viewers staying on the premises of each of the facilities listed in §1 point 1 are required to comply with the messages located in the spaces of the above-mentioned facilities and to follow the recommendations of organizational employees, volunteers, staff and security services.

**3.** Children under 4 years of age and people with a confirmed degree of disability do not have to wear a mask. Such persons must have appropriate certificates and have them with them at all times. In the event of not having a certificate, the person will be asked to leave the facility or immediately apply the regulations and legal provisions.

**4.** In front of each of the buildings and in the buildings and other venues involved in the tournament, it is required to keep a safe distance from other people (in accordance with the ordinance and law) and avoid gathering (applies to building entrances, corridors, meal lines, toilets, etc. - the exceptions are the necessary work of the organizational staff of the tournament as well as tournament matches and people actively participating in them).

**5.** People infected with the SARS-COV-2 virus or those subject to mandatory quarantine are not allowed to participate in events organized by Around The Sport. If, during the competition, any person on the site receives a quarantine message or a positive test result, they are asked to notify the nearest organizer or volunteer.

**6.** The team leader is obliged to submit a statement about his health and the health of the entire team he has reported (including adults) confirming that:

- 1) To the best of my knowledge, there is no person infected with the SARSCOV-2 virus or who has any symptoms listed as possible symptoms of disease caused by this virus;
- 2) He is not in quarantine or under the epidemiological supervision of state institutions, not only in the Republic of Poland, but also in similar institutions around the world;

if he develops symptoms of COVID-19 he will not participate in the event and inform about including the head person of the team and the organizer of the "Wrocław Handball Cup" tournament, ie the "Around The Sport" Sports Agency and the "Handball Śląsk Wrocław" Handball Club.

**7.** The declaration referred to in paragraph 1. 6 (this is reading the regulations and agreeing to participate in the tournament and all the requirements that have been established), is signed at the latest in the written version when registering the team. Failure to submit a written statement about the health of the entire team (signing the regulations - it is equivalent) prevents participation in the event. In this case, each participant of the event who did not make such an intermediation (or the person authorized to represent it) is not entitled to any claims against Around The Sport and the persons and institutions co-organizing it.

**8.** Event participants may submit a health declaration by means of communication when registering for a given event, but it is still necessary to make a declaration when registering a team.

**9.** Information about the purposes and principles of collecting personal data is included in the health declaration, i.e. in the regulations, which each participant signs on the so-called consent list. The collection of personal data also has marketing goals related to the activities of the "Around The Sport" Sports Agency.



communication routes, ie on paths, entrances to objects through, for example, doors, etc., it is recommended that people who want to leave the object should first wait, and only then enter after making sure that there are no people behind the "door". The organizers, volunteers, players and guardians of the teams participating in the tournament have priority in moving around the facilities.

**11.** The number of guests staying in the building at the same time has been reduced and is constantly dependent on sanitary requirements. Please follow the instructions of the tournament organizers and the law.

**12.** The obligation to keep a distance between participants does not apply to a participant who:

- 1) is a player and is currently participating in the tournament as included in the report;
- 2) is the coach or team guardian during the match and participates in the tournament at the moment as included in the report;
- 3) is a referee of a given match (ie a match) and is currently participating in the tournament as included in the tournament's cast;
- 4) is a person working in the staff of the organizers of the "Wrocław Handball Cup" and performs at the moment the duties necessary for its smooth running;
- 5) is a volunteer accredited by "Around The Sport" for the time of the "Wrocław Handball Cup" and performs at the moment the duties necessary for its smooth running.

**13.** In facilities where you can go to a canteen, follow the rules:

- 1) The organizer of the canteen or any of the staff or tournament organizers or organizers may in any subsequent place that needs to be replaced
- 2) In the canteen there is a high sanitary rigor, i.e. Copying food until consumption is prohibited and obligatory, which are available in many sections of the regulations, including the obligatory covering of the mouth, including the obligatory
- 3) Before entering the canteen facility, it is mandatory to use hands to make hands, is it possible to obtain protective gloves (preferably disposable)
- 4) In the canteen at sitting and standing places, there is a rigor of 2 meters from the emission of a person and applies to all persons who are authorized to stay in this place, except for people from the same apartment.
- 5) Panabsolutny ban on smoking, e-cigarettes and a person ago
- 6) It is absolutely forbidden to consume alcohol
- 7) There is absolute legal supervision with the provision from all control points and legal powers in regulations and other legal acts.
- 8) In the event of changes in the legal provisions regarding the consumption of food in a confined space related to a similar activity to restaurants, the situation without changing the regulations adjusts itself spontaneously following the letter of the law.

**14.** Due to the risk of transmission of the SARS-COV-2 virus on outerwear and luggage, the cloakroom function is changed to changing rooms and therefore the organizer is not responsible for items left in the room called the "cloakroom". The cloakroom at the moment of the tournament (ie August 24-28, 2021) is a place only for safe changing of clothes. The organizer will not run the so-called So there is no possibility of filing complaints about lost items, items of clothing and other items. Only the players and, in exceptional cases, the team leaders have access to the room called the "dressing room" during the tournament. Other outsiders may enter the room, but only with the express consent of



the organizer (usually in writing, and in the case of oral consent, an outsider may only enter with a representative of the tournament, i.e. a member of the organizing committee or a volunteer). Outerwear is taken to the facilities listed in §1 point 1 and taken with you after changing clothes. In this case, the organizer is not responsible for items, items of clothing and the like that will be lost.

**15.** In case of rain / snow / hail, please do not bring an umbrella. However, if this happens, please take as small as possible such an item and foil packaging to store the umbrella during the event.

**16.** It is not possible to store luggage on the premises.

**17.** Each person staying in the building should limit the time spent in each of the sports facilities to the necessary minimum, including before and after the event, and also limit movement to all facilities listed in §1 point 1.

**18.** Players and team leaders taking part in the match at the moment must follow the following procedures:

1) Until the pitch of the pitch designated for play for teams is entered, all sanitary restrictions included in the Polish and EU regulations as well as these regulations apply.

2) The next teams entitled to play in a given place may only enter earlier said place at the time when a previous game ended and previous teams had left the designated area of play for the competition.

3) After taking their places, the persons authorized to play as well as the referee of the competition have the right to stay without a mask in accordance with the rules of sports competition as well as health and life safety.

4) All bystanders and people not taking an active part in a given match, i.e. the match, are obliged to respect all the organizer's recommendations and stay only in designated zones. The obligation to respect these rules rests not with the organizer, but with the team leaders. In the event that bystanders interfere in any way with the running of the "Wrocław Handball Cup" tournament, the judge of the competition or any of the organizers has the right to initiate a procedure to remedy the situation, and if the situation is not corrected, he may even punish the teams participating in the meeting with the so-called . forfeit or exclusion from the "Wrocław Handball Cup" tournament, inclusive. In the event that these people represent other teams or are their members, the organizer institutes proceedings against them and may even punish them with the penalty of exclusion from the entire "Wrocław Handball Cup" tournament, inclusive.

5) Tournament participants leave the designated places on each instruction of the staff. They also do it in a situation similar to that provided for in §3 sec. 19 points 2, so after each match, we kindly ask you to leave the field of play as soon as possible, without thanking the opposing team and referees for the game in any physical form (even by clashing your hands with clenched fingers, or by contacting your elbows). as well as competitors keep contact with a safe distance of 2 meters. In exceptional cases, the referee has the power to reduce this distance, but at all times it must be supported by football rules as well as national or international general law. 7) Players of opposing teams keep a distance of at least 2 meters between themselves until the beginning of each part of the match as well as from the end of their first and second parts. In this case, it is obvious that the players of both teams are not officially greeted in any physical form (even by clashing hands with clasped fingers or by contact with elbows).

**20.** In situations not covered by the regulations - the binding decision is always made by the



organizers of the tournament, ie the Sports Agency "Around The Sport" and the Handball Club "Handball Śląsk Wrocław". No other legal entity (term within the meaning of the acts) without express consent may dictate conditions other than those in the regulations without the express consent of the aforementioned institution of the organizer and its employees. Any final decision of the organizational staff cannot be appealed.

**21.** Participation in the event is tantamount to accepting these regulations and there is no possibility of respecting other regulations.

#### **§4**

##### **Ensuring the safety of tournament participants**

**1.** In order to ensure the safety of participants of the "Wrocław Handball Cup", the organizer uses the following measures:

- 1) provides the option of collecting disposable masks at sports facilities, but calls for using theirs for hygiene reasons, as well as informs about the limited number of available masks for lending;
- 2) provides a liquid for disinfection, but calls for the use of its own for hygienic reasons, as well as informs about its limited amount;
- 3) puts the welfare of people who are players and take part in the tournament together with them above all, and all other people inform that the tournament is being held for the players by asking them to obey all the rules;
- 4) ensures compliance with the regulations on its part;
- 5) will try to fix any sanitary deficiencies immediately;

#### **§ 5**

##### **Sensitive data and facsimile**

**1.** Each participant of the event acknowledges by participating in the tournament (which is analogous to the acceptance of the regulations) that the entire period of the event and all side events related to the event itself - can be recorded by persons designated by using video, audio, audio and video equipment. , including digital, analog or any other derivative existing. While recording the course of the event and accompanying events / events, the image of all people present at the facilities may be recorded and shared. Bystanders entering the facility also accept the regulations of the event without signing any consent.

**2.** Fixed broadcasts of events along with a fixed image of participants and third parties can be strengthened and encouraged to archive, statutory, promotional or promotional events of a given event. The image may also be published in advance in a form that is appropriate under copyright law.

**3.** The image of an event participant may be developed and modified with respect for personal rights.



please resign from participation in the event. Here, as in the previously mentioned cases, the person has no rights to claim against the organizer and cooperating entities.

## **§ 6**

### **Final provisions**

**1.** A person who does not comply with the above-mentioned guidelines may not be admitted to any of the facilities listed in §1 section 1 or asked to leave the building during the event. In this case, the event participant is not entitled to any claims against the organizer.

**2.** It is recommended to keep up-to-date with the information provided by means of verbal communication at the facilities as well as by electronic means (in the form of an e-mail or text message, and even a direct telephone number to the event participant).
